


Working on a small international team, you'll develop skills like collaboration and creativity as you use the design thinking process to propose solutions to global communication challenges.

#### Why Spain?

You can't communicate without language, and it's nearly impossible to separate language from the personalities and perspectives of the people who speak it. On tour, you'll gain insight into all the things influencing the Spanish language as you converse with locals in Madrid and Barcelona. This Language Immersion Tour will expand your fluency in Spanish and inspire a love for where it's from.

#### Days 1-4: Madrid | Toledo

Fly overnight to Madrid and meet your Tour Director before beginning your journey in the vibrant capital city of Spain. Because your tour combines authentic cultural experiences with interactive language lessons, you'll get firsthand experience with modern communication in Madrid and during a day trip to Toledo. Practice your conversational Spanish and learn more about living in Spain's capital as you meet and mingle with locals. Interact with vendors and sample popular Spanish foods during a market challenge, then try your hand at preparing authentic Spanish dishes while attending a cooking class.

#### Days 5-7: Barcelona

Take a train to Barcelona, a city that celebrates its unique identity through language, art, and culture. Witness the influence of Antoni Gaudí, one of Spain's most renowned architects, throughout the striking city. Take a guided tour of Park Güell, a beautiful municipal garden designed by Gaudí, and his cathedral masterpiece: La Sagrada Familia. You'll continue your language lessons in Barcelona, and get an opportunity to practice the new words and phrases you learn during a cultural exchange activity with locals. Whether it's a pickup soccer game, a student-guided walking tour, or a community project, you'll hear about life in Spain from those who know it best and continue to expand your knowledge of the Spanish language.

#### Day 8: Zurich | Davos

Fly from Barcelona to Zurich on your way to Davos. Located in Graubünden, the innovative mountainside town is where your three-day leadership conference will take place.

#### Days 9-11: Leadership Conference

Enjoy a scenic cable car ride and a bit of free time to explore Davos before the conference kicks off on Friday night. You'll engage in some friendly competition with other Summit attendees, and be encouraged to step outside your comfort zone as you get to know the team you will work with over the next few days. On Saturday, the leadership conference continues as you collaborate with students from across North America and the world in this inspiring setting. Over the course of the entire weekend, you'll hear from world-renowned speakers, converse with local and global experts, and work in small international teams to harness *The Power of Communication*. The event will strengthen your creativity and critical thinking skills as you use design thinking to develop solutions that improve the way the world communicates.

#### Day 12: Depart for home

Head to the Zurich airport ready to address local challenges and initiate meaningful conversations back home.
