What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Day 2: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own.
- Tour London and learn about some of England's legendary figures. You will see places like Jimi Hendrix's flat in the Mayfair neighborhood, MI6 headquarters (a landmark for James Bond fans), Florence Nightingale's training hospital, and other insider sites suggested by your Tour Director.

Day 3: London

- Take a guided "Legends of London" tour.
 With your expert local guide you will see sites like Westminster, Buckingham Palace, and Big Ben.
- Explore London on your own or
- visit Windsor Castle, the Royal Family's retreat. This half-day jaunt to the home where Queen Elizabeth spends many of her weekends includes a look at Henry VIII's suit of armor and St. George's Chapel, where Prince Harry and Meghan Markle wed.

Day 4: London

- Visit the Tower of London, a medieval castle and former prison, to hear the stories behind its stone façade.
- Take a Thames River Cruise to Greenwich.
- Visit the Royal Observatory in Greenwich.
 Stand on the Prime Meridian, dividing the world's hemispheres, and see astrological attractions that include a 4.5-billion-year-old meteorite and an octagonal room designed for stargazing.

Day 5: London | Avebury | Bath | Bristol region

- Travel via Avebury and Bath to the Bristol region.
- Visit the standing stones in Avebury. This historic site, constructed during the Neolithic period, is Britain's largest stone circle.
- Visit the Roman baths in Bath.
- Explore Bath on your own.

Day 6: Bristol region

- Stop for a photo at Clifton Suspension Bridge.
 This iron icon, which spans Avon Gorge, owes its design to renowned British engineer Isambard Kingdom Brunel.
- Take a guided street art tour of Bristol with a local artist. See a variety of local street art and learn about Banksy, Bristol's hometown hero. Let the city's art scene inspire you as you create your own stencil art with a spray can, which you can take home.
- Visit Brunel's SS Great Britain, a historic transatlantic steamship.

Day 7: Bristol region | Stratford-upon-Avon | Warwick | Birmingham region

- Travel via Stratford-upon-Avon and Warwick to the Birmingham region.
- Visit Shakespeare's Birthplace. Step back into the Elizabethan age as you tour the halftimbered house where William Shakespeare was born. The playwright had an unmistakable influence on his hometown: today, Stratfordupon-Avon is home to the Royal Shakespeare Theatre and a premier destination for theater lovers worldwide.
- Visit Warwick Castle. (Pro tip: Locals don't pronounce the second "w.")

Day 8: Birmingham region | Nottingham | Cheshire region

- Travel via Nottingham to the Cheshire region.
- Take a guided tour of Nottingham through the footsteps of its most famous outlaw.
 Dressed as Robin Hood, your expert guide will share the tales and trials of this heroic figure.
- Visit Wollaton Hall, which you may recognize as Wayne Manor from many Batman films. You'll have time to explore this stately home and its surrounding gardens.

Day 9: Cheshire region

- Travel to Liverpool, a northwestern port city with a strong musical heritage.
- Take a guided tour of Liverpool on a River Mersey ferry.
- Explore Royal Albert Dock and the Liverpool waterfront on your own. The area is home to shops, cafés, and the poignant International Slavery Museum that examines the transatlantic slave trade—in which Liverpool played a prominent roll.
- Visit the British Music Experience. Discover more about England's musical milestones, including Liverpool's world-famous export, The Beatles.

Day 10: Cheshire region

- Visit Old Trafford, home of Manchester United.
- Visit the The Lowry museum, featuring the works of Industrial Revolution artist L.S. Lowry.
- Explore Manchester's shopping district on your own.
