

What you'll experience on your tour

Days 1-2: Fly to New Zealand

- Cross the International Date Line.

Day 3: Auckland

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport.
- Take a tour of Auckland.
- Visit Auckland Sky Tower, the tallest building in New Zealand, where you'll enjoy a bird's-eye view of the city from the observation deck.

Day 4: Hokianga

- Travel to Hokianga, one of the earliest settlements of the Maori people in *Aotearoa*, or New Zealand, and home to some of the most picturesque landscapes in the world.
- Afterward, enjoy a visit to the Kawiti Glow Worm Caves.
- Take a twilight walking tour through the magnificent Waipoua Forest.

Day 5: Hokianga | Paihia

- Visit a marae, a Maori meeting house used for important tribal events like celebrations and funerals.
- Enjoy a traditional Maori martial arts and weaving demonstration.
- Travel to Paihia, the main hub of the Bay of Islands.
- En route, take a relaxing dip in the Waiariki hot pools.

Day 6: Russell Island | Paihia

- Cruise around the Bay of Islands on the lookout for dolphins.
- Explore Russell Island, the first permanent European settlement in New Zealand.
- Return to Paihia via ferry.
- Participate in a guided tour of the Waitangi
 Treaty Grounds and Museum, an important site in both British and Maori history.
- Enjoy a traditional *hangi* dinner complete with a Maori song and dance performance.

Day 7: Paihia | Brisbane | Sunshine Coast

- Fly to Brisbane, Australia, then transfer to Habitat Noosa, a renovated summer camp where you're guaranteed to see wild kangaroos!
- Enjoy an afternoon exploring the Sunshine Coast campground.

Days 8: Sunshine Coast

- Explore the mangrove forests of Great Sandy National Park on a full-day canoe excursion.
- Enjoy morning tea and an authentic Aussie BBQ lunch.

Days 9: Sunshine Coast

- Enjoy free time, or
 - enjoy a ranger-led all-day hike exploring Fraser Island's unique ecology.

Days 10-11: Surfers Paradise

- Transfer to Surfers Paradise, the capital
 of the Gold Coast and a costal region of
 southern Brisbane. The region is famed for
 its long sandy beaches, elaborate system of
 waterways, and, of course, picturesque
 surf spots.
- Enjoy free beach time or
 enjoy a 4x4 rainforest tour.

Day 12: Brisbane | Sydney

- Travel to Brisbane.
- Fly to Sydney, a stunning, cosmopolitan city of 4.6 million people that boasts world-class beaches, iconic architecture, and breathtaking natural wonders.

Day 13: Sydney

- Take a walking tour of Sydney.
- Visit the Hyde Park Barracks Museum.
- Visit the National Opal Collection.
- Take a walking tour of the Rocks neighborhood.
- Enjoy a guided tour of the Royal Botanical Gardens.

Day 14: Sydney

Spend the day exploring Sydney, or
 visit Taronga Zoo and the Opera House.

Day 16: Great Barrier Reef | Port Douglas

 Board a cruise in Port Douglas, a famed Australian pirate town, and spend the day soaking up the sun and seeing one of nature's great wonders: the Great Barrier Reef.

Day 17: Great Barrier Reef | Port Douglas

 Travel to Cape Tribulation and spend the day hiking through the rainforest and trawling for crocodiles on a crocodile river tour.
